

QRonicle version 1.0 User Manual

Welcome to QRonicle!

QRonicle is the easiest way to access your cloud documentation directly from a DAW project. It is a simple utility plug-in that helps producers and engineers document anything about a DAW session - such as hardware settings, mic positions, and instrument patches - and share them with collaborators.



What Makes it Different?

QRonicle only stores the URL of a cloud document. This allows for all of the benefits of using an external cloud service for the documentation such as:

- Support for many different file formats and document types
- Access permissions management
- Version history
- Editable without opening the session
- Editable on a separate device such as a smart phone
- Familiarity

Furthermore, because the plug-in avoids embedding assets, it prevents unnecessary increases in project file size, thus avoiding potential storage, performance, or file transfer complications.

How to Use QRonicle

QRonicle is for anyone who uses cloud services (e.g. Google Drive, Microsoft 365, Evernote, Dropbox, etc. *) for session documentation.

1. Create session documentation using the desired cloud service.
2. On the DAW session, instantiate QRonicle on any track.
 - QRonicle is inserted on a track as an audio plug-in, but does not process signal; the audio is simply passed through.
 - QRonicle can be inserted on any track width/format.
3. Copy the URL for the cloud document and paste into QRonicle. A QR code is created.
4. Optionally type in the title to describe the linked document.
5. Either scan the QR code with a mobile device or click on it to open the document.

What can you do with this thing?

QRonicle can be inserted on individual tracks for information specific to each track, or on the mix bus for project wide documentation:

- Mic placements
- Room plan
- Hardware settings
- Instrument settings
- Effect pedal settings
- Lyric sheets
- Mix notes
- Version notes
- Music notation
- Credits

Use your phone to capture photos and notes for the project, or review the info while running the DAW on your computer.

Installation & Authorization

1. Download the installer from fskaudio.io/installations and run it.
2. After the installation, launch your DAW and instantiate a QRonicle.
3. A prompt for activating QRonicle will appear. You will be asked to sign into your iLok account.
 - Alternatively, you can authorize QRonicle using [iLok License Manager](#) prior to opening QRonicle on your DAW.

The installer will install the following plug-in formats:

- AAX
- VST3
- AU (Mac only)

The Header



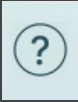
The Header contains help links and preferences.

Opens a menu with more help resources.

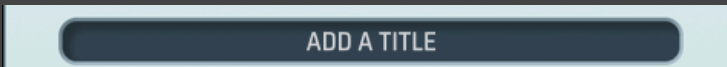
Preferences



Window Size - A few zoom settings are provided to resize the plug-in window.

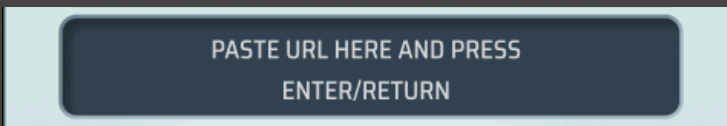
Main Section

Title Field



Optionally type in a description of the URL.

URL Field



Paste or type in a URL, then press Return or Enter to generate a QR code.

QR Code Display



Scan or click the QR code to open the link.

Window Resize Handle



Drag the lower right corner to resize the window.

- The windows size can also be changed and reset from the Preferences menu.
